Interview Questions	<p>Question 1: Does this candidate exhibit a desire to learn?</p> <p>Answer: Jane reports being excited by the variety of patient types they will encounter in the Emergency Department but voiced concern about caring for behavioral health patients</p> <p>Question 2: What learning needs would be required to help this candidate be successful?</p> <p>Answer: Jane seemed to have a strong personality and would need a preceptor who could challenge pre-existing bias from their experience on the floor and to help her practice with good clinical judgement. She will need 16-20 wks with preceptor simulation, ACLS, PALS, ENCP, TNCC.</p> <p>Question 3: Would this candidate benefit from participating in simulation?</p> <p>Answer: yes, particularly simulation 1: Initial Patient Care / Bias</p> <p>Comments: Concerned that her previous experience as a tech has created bias and that in her role as a nurse she will need to be able to identify her bias and ensure that she is completing care without bias. Should she present herself differently on the floor while shadowing she could be successful</p>
